it should be of interest to you, that upon review of the easement you rely upon; we have two such instruments involved book 454 page 368 which occurs first on 1/20/1952 establishing an easement which says "poles, posts, and anchors shall be set: as stated".

The second instrument of easement book 489 page 225 being established on 3/11/1953 being for the same purpose entirely; is then a reissuing of the same and as it appears a year later; then governs the first. It is noted in this second instrument: starting with "poles, posts, and anchors shall be set": then contains scratched out words so as to remove them from the document. Reinstating instead the following words shall govern the second instrument. Which does establish these words as the primary and true purpose of the easement itself. They are: "one foot off the road right of way along east side of above described property".

The legal instrument, which allows you to place the anchor within the field falls short of your intended authority: as it was in fact replaced with the second easement clearly stating you have the right to go one foot off the road right of way".

Do you wish to contest this; or simply be done; by moving this pole anchor?
